First ECO Park delivery to public facility



OTEPIA, a library and museum complex building jointly completed by Kochi Prefecture and Kochi City, installed one unit of ECO Park. This installation is the first delivery to a public facility. This ECO Park is an exclusive model that accommodates 60 vehicles, ten more than the standard model. The tubular piles were installed in a cylindrical form by Giken's press-in methodology to construct the underground structure. To attract visitors, a broad area of the exterior part of the exit and entry booth is in a glass. Visitors often come to enjoy the view of the parking processfrom this glass. The installation embodies Giken's concept of "Cultural Aboveground and Function Underground," and creates an open space aboveground.




